	Mandrake's Mystery: Upon entry to the Faire be sure to ask the Greeters for a copy of Mandrake's Mystery. This free game will have you laughing all day as you attempt to solve a game of "Renaissance Clue" by interacting with various performers. This one is a must if you want to have more fun! There are new mysteries every weekend of the show.
	Secret Unicorn Game: We've hidden the Faire Unicorn Logo in over 60 different locations. Can you find them all? Write your answers on the back of this itinerary. Good luck!
	Entertainment Program & Schedule: If you weren't handed a free Entertainment Program and Schedule of Events when you walked into the Faire be sure to get one from our Greeters at the entry gate. This will give you a summary of all performers and when and where they are performing.
	Watch the Shows: It can take up to 6 straight days to see every show at the Faire so if you are only planning to visit once, stop by our Souvenir Booth and ask attendants for show suggestions.
	Have your Vows Renewed by his Holiness the Pope: If you're a married couple check our schedule to see which weekend and time our free vow renewals are being held.
	Get Married: Not only is the faire a romantic place to propose (ask how we can help), it's also a great place to tie the knot. If you're considering getting married at the faire, stop by our wedding tent for details.
	Share a Dessert: Stop by "Sir Munch a Lot" for chocolate covered cheesecake, bananas, or strawberries. You can't lose!
	Interact with our Street Cast: Take a moment to chat with our costumed actors. Ask them what they do in the village and engage them in conversation. They want to talk to you and help you step back in time.
	Stay for Halloween Knights: On certain evenings the Faire stays open late for a special Halloween event. Have an excuse to hold hands and stay for the haunted joust, fire shows, zombie walk-and-dance, and more.
	Dance Together: Every day of the Faire we teach various dances you'd see at an old-world festival. Check your schedule and join us as we teach you the steps of courtly love and romance.
	Smite the Knight: Challenge the Black Knight to a duel to defend the honor of your true love.
	A Rose on Bended Knee: Purchase a romantic rose from one of our rose wenches and present it on bended knee.
	Explore the Marketplace: Browse through all of our merchant shops and look for things that catch your eye. From jewelry, housewares and clothing to swords, armor, collectibles, and toys there is something for everyone at the Faire.
	See the Joust: Take the time to see armored knights on horseback trying to knock each other off with colored lances. Cheer for your favorite knight. The most attended joust of the day is the final joust which is a *must-see* show.
	Final Sing: Attend the Final Sing which contains creative (and often humorous) songs and skits made by our talented performers. Don't miss the last show of the day!
	Get a Memento: Stop by our Souvenir Booth on your way out of the Faire and purchase a memento of your first faire experience. We recommend our quality t-shirts and sweatshirts. If you are planning to return to the Faire consider purchasing a season pass while you're there and come back to enjoy many more days of fun with us.
