The 23rd annual Connecticut Renaissance Faire is an enchanted recreation of a 16th-century harvest fair as one might have been long ago.

- **Location:** Lebanon Lions Fairgrounds at 122 Mack Road in Lebanon, Connecticut. Minutes from Hartford, New London, and Northeast, Connecticut.
- **Dates:** Every Saturday and Sunday from September 4 to October 17, Plus Labor Day & Columbus Day Mondays (7 consecutive weekends). 10:30 am to 6:00 pm.
- **Cost:** General Admission (ages 16+) is \$15; Youth Admission (ages 7-15) is \$10; Child Admission (ages 0-6) are FREE. Tickets available online or at the Faire box office.
- **VIP:** Purchase VIP tickets online and get treated like royalty.
- **Parking:** Parking is free with kind donations requested from non-profit fundraisers running the lot.
- **Attendance:** 35,000+
- The Connecticut Renaissance Faire features themed, circus-style entertainment coupled with outdoor theatre and New England's largest Medieval Craft Marketplace. More than 60 performances daily.
- The whole village is a stage with interactive performances in the market streets and continuous themed entertainment on ten stages.
- Test your skill at arms with archery, ax throwing, knife toss, the test of strength, escape room, maze, and other Renaissance games.
- Participate in a live-flight birds of prey show, see real jousting knights, and see why plate mail ruled that battlefield for more than 100 years with live combat demos.
- The Harp Twins visit the Connecticut Renaissance Faire on October 2-3. This dynamic duo has headlined countless concert series, festivals, fairs, comic cons, and conventions – with audiences that include former U.S. Presidents and Vice Presidents, tech titans, fashion moguls, dignitaries, and world leaders. The Harp Twins deliver exciting, comedic, and interactive family-friendly performances.
