Here are the fast facts:

- **Location:** The Connecticut Renaissance Faire will take place at the Lebanon Lions Fairgrounds at 122 Mack Road in Lebanon, Connecticut. The fairgrounds are just a few minutes from Hartford, New London, and Northeast Connecticut.
- **Dates and Times:** The Faire will be open every Saturday and Sunday from September 2 to October 15, plus Labor Day and Columbus Day Mondays, for a total of seven consecutive weekends. The Faire is open from 10:30 am to 6:00 pm each day.
- **Admission:** General Admission for ages 16 and up is \$16, Youth Admission for ages 7-15 is \$10, and children ages 6 and under are free. Tickets can be purchased online or at the Faire box office.
- **Parking:** Parking is free, but the Faire kindly requests donations for the non-profit fundraisers who are running the lot.
- **Attendance:** Last year, over 50,000 guests traveled back in time to experience the Connecticut Renaissance Faire.
- **Themed Entertainment:** The Faire will feature more than 60 performances daily, including themed circus-style entertainment, interactive performances in the market streets, and continuous entertainment on ten stages.
- **Renaissance Games:** Test your skill at arms with archery, ax throwing, knife toss, the test of strength, escape room, maze, tomato torment, and other Renaissance games.

- **Live Entertainment:** Visitors can participate in a live-flight birds of prey show, watch real jousting knights, and see live combat demos showcasing the power of plate mail on the battlefield.
