

Media Visit Guidelines

Visiting the Connecticut Renaissance Faire on assignment? Here's what you need to know for a smooth and magical experience.

CHECKING IN

If you haven't arranged advance access, simply visit the front gate and speak to Lady Rebecca. She'll summon Eric to verify credentials and offer a brief overview of the day. Media are welcome anytime during Faire hours.

PHOTOGRAPHY & FILMING

- Professional cameras and tripods are allowed - no special credentials needed.
- Please remain in public-access areas unless granted escort backstage.
- Filming of shows and jousts is permitted, but if a performer asks you to stop, please respect the request.

COSTUMES & IDENTIFICATION

- Costumes are not required, but they're always welcome - especially for broadcast footage.
- Press will be escorted by Eric, who can assist with interviews and introductions.

INTERVIEWS

- Cast members will remain in character for impromptu interviews unless pre-approved by management.
- Media are welcome to speak with any willing guests.
- Eric can assist with coordinating access to performers and guests.

BEST TIMES TO VISIT

- Arrive around 10:30 AM for the best parking.
- Ideal media days include:
 - * Neighbor Appreciation Day (Aug 30): Interview local residents.
 - * Free Kids Day (Sep 6): Connect with families and Kate Schneider from Kidtivity.com, our event sponsor.
