Jousting, music, magic, and more, all included without paying a king's ransom

Lebanon, Connecticut – [July 13, 2025]: This fall, step into a world of knights, dragons, jesters, and royalty without paying a king's ransom. The Connecticut Renaissance Faire invites families, adventurers, and daydreamers to enjoy a full day of shows, shopping, food, and fantasy fun starting at just \$16.

From the thunder of jousting to the laughter of roving performers and music from top acts traveling in from across the United States and Canada, every show is included with admission. There are no hidden fees, no add-on packages, and no premium passes required to enjoy the magic.

"We want people to come have a great time without worrying about the cost," said Eric Tetreault, Co-Owner of the Connecticut Renaissance Faire. **"It shouldn't take a big budget to make big memories with your family or your friends."**

General admission is \$16 for adults, \$10 for youth, and free for children ages 6 and under. Discounts are available for seniors and military families. Pets are also welcome with a \$5 ticket and proof of rabies vaccination. Season passes are available for guests who plan to return multiple times.

Food is just as accessible. Dozens of independent vendors offer everything from giant turkey legs and sweet treats to \$7 meal deals and affordable beverages. Parking is always free and is managed by nonprofit volunteers as part of their fundraising efforts.

The Faire's commitment to affordability goes beyond pricing. Every year, the Connecticut Renaissance Faire donates approximately \$30,000 worth of tickets to schools, charities, and local community groups to help more families share in the experience.

The 2025 season runs weekends and holidays from August 30 through October 19 at the Lebanon Fairgrounds. Tickets and full event details are available now at ctfaire.com. Guests who join the free Insiders Club will receive early bird discounts and helpful planning tips before Opening Day.
